

Trispark Java DICOM Toolkit License Agreement

TRISPARK IS WILLING TO LICENSE THE ACCOMPANYING JAVA DICOM TOOLKIT SOFTWARE AND ASSOCIATED DOCUMENTATION INCLUDING AUTHORIZED COPIES OF EACH (THE "SOFTWARE") TO YOU ("LICENSEE") ONLY ON THE CONDITION THAT LICENSEE ACCEPTS ALL OF THE TERMS IN THIS AGREEMENT

PLEASE READ THE TERMS CAREFULLY BEFORE INSTALLING THE SOFTWARE. BY INSTALLING THE SOFTWARE, LICENSEE ACKNOWLEDGES THAT LICENSEE HAS READ AND UNDERSTANDS THIS AGREEMENT AND AGREES TO BE BOUND BY ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS. IF LICENSEE DOES NOT ACCEPT THESE LICENSE TERMS, THEN TRISPARK DOES NOT GRANT ANY LICENSE TO THE SOFTWARE, AND LICENSEE MUST NOT INSTALL THE SOFTWARE.

1. Grant of license

1.1 Evaluation license

If you downloaded a trial or evaluation version of the Software from Trispark's website or obtained it through other means, you may install and use one copy of the Software on a single computer of your organization, for evaluation and testing purposes during the evaluation period. You may not use the Software for commercial purposes. The Software may contain a disabling mechanism that will prevent it from being used after the evaluation period. You must not tamper with the disabling mechanism or the Software. After the evaluation period, if you do not order the registered version of the Software, you must remove/destroy the Software and Documentation

1.2 Developer license (JDT-DEV)

A developer license grants the use of the Software for the purpose of software development to an individual developer. If you have purchased a developer license the Software may be used within your organization by a single developer to develop applications. Multiple copies of the Software may exist on more than one computer, as long as the use of the Software is by the same developer. In addition, you are permitted to deploy a single application making use of the Software within your organization. A developer license does not grant you the right to distribute the Software or use the Software outside your organization.

1.3 Runtime license (JDT-RTU)

If you purchased a runtime license you are permitted to distribute the software an unlimited number of times, provided that you:

- a. distribute the applications that are built with the Software only in conjunction with and as an integral part of your Web pages, and distribute the class libraries only as an integral part of your end-user application.
- b. your Web pages or software product(s) are targeted at end-users and are not a development tool;
- c. you do not use Trispark's name, logo or trademark to market your Web pages or application without explicit agreement with Trispark;
- d. you include a valid copyright notice on your Web pages and software products.

1.4 Source code license (JDT-SRC)

If you have purchased the source code license of the Software, you must use reasonable efforts to maintain the confidentiality of the source code, including ensuring that it is installed and used only

on the machines belonging to Licensee's organization, for development of applets and applications that use the Software and that the source code is not otherwise used or copied.

1.5 Use Definition

The SOFTWARE is "in use" on a computer when it is loaded into temporary memory (i.e. RAM) or installed into permanent memory (e.g. hard disk, CD-ROM, or other storage device) of that computer, except that a copy installed on a network server for the sole purpose of distribution to other computers is not "in use".

2. Modification

Licensee may not modify the Java Dicom Toolkit Interface ("JDT", identified as classes contained within the "com.archimed" package or any sub packages of the "com.archimed" package), by creating additional classes within the JDT or otherwise causing the addition to or modification of the classes in the JDT. In the event that Licensee creates any Java-related API and distributes such API to others for applet or application development, Licensee must promptly publish an accurate specification for such API for free use by all developers of Java-based software. Licensees that are bound by a source code license may modify JDT by adding classes to JDT or modifying existing JDT classes, only if modified or added classes are defined outside the "com.archimed" package tree.

3. Restrictions.

Software is confidential copyrighted information of Trispark and title to all copies is retained by Trispark and/or its licensors. Licensee shall not decompile, disassemble, decrypt, extract, or otherwise reverse engineer Software. Software may not be leased, assigned, or sublicensed, in whole or in part. Software is not designed or intended for use in on-line control of aircraft, air traffic, aircraft navigation or aircraft communications; or in the design, construction, operation or maintenance of any nuclear facility. Licensee warrants that it will not use or redistribute the Software for such purposes.

4. Trademarks and Logos.

This Agreement does not authorize Licensee to use any Trispark name, trademark or logo.

5. Disclaimer of Warranty.

Software is provided "AS IS," without a warranty of any kind. ALL EXPRESS OR IMPLIED REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES, INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR NON-INFRINGEMENT, ARE HEREBY EXCLUDED.

6. Limitation of Liability.

TRISPARK AND ITS LICENSORS SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGES SUFFERED BY LICENSEE OR ANY THIRD PARTY AS A RESULT OF USING OR DISTRIBUTING SOFTWARE. IN NO EVENT WILL TRISPARK OR ITS LICENSORS BE LIABLE FOR ANY LOST REVENUE, PROFIT OR DATA, OR FOR DIRECT, INDIRECT, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES, HOWEVER CAUSED AND REGARDLESS OF THE THEORY OF LIABILITY, ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF OR INABILITY TO USE SOFTWARE, EVEN IF TRISPARK HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES. The Software or the

use of the Software may be subject to regulatory provisions related to products used in the Health Care Industry. Prior to using the Software, it is Licensee's responsibility to ensure that Licensee's use of the Software will not violate any legal or regulatory provisions.

7. Termination.

Licensee may terminate this Agreement at any time by destroying all copies of Software. This Agreement will terminate immediately without notice from Trispark if Licensee fails to comply with any provision of this Agreement or when the period for which this license holds expires. Upon such termination, Licensee must destroy all copies of Software in its possession.

8. Severability.

If any of the above provisions are held to be in violation of applicable law, void, or unenforceable in any jurisdiction, then such provisions are herewith waived or amended to the extent necessary for the Agreement to be otherwise enforceable in such jurisdiction. However, if in Trispark's opinion deletion or amendment of any provisions of the Agreement by operation of this paragraph unreasonably compromises the rights or increase the liabilities of Trispark or its licensors, Trispark reserves the right to terminate the Agreement.

9. Publicity.

In the event that licensee has obtained a developer license, runtime license or source code license, Trispark reserves the right to reference Licensee as one of Trispark's customers by mentioning Licensee's company name in documents such as, but not limited to, web pages of Trispark's website, emails originating from Trispark's employees, publicity brochures and fact sheets, unless explicitly stated otherwise by Licensee. In no event shall Trispark publish any other information about Licensee other than the single fact that Licensee is a customer of Trispark.

10. Entire Agreement.

This Agreement is the parties' entire agreement relating to the Software. It supersedes all prior or contemporaneous oral or written communications, proposals, warranties, and representations with respect to its subject matter, and following Licensee's acceptance of this license by clicking on the "Accept" Button, will prevail over any conflicting or additional terms of any quote, order, acknowledgment, or any other communications by or between the parties. No modification to this Agreement will be binding, unless in writing and signed by an authorized representative of each party.
